MEMORANDUM OPINION

On November 10, 2021, relator U.L., filed a petition and, thereafter, an amended petition for writ of mandamus in this Court. *See* Tex. Gov't Code Ann. § 22.221; *see also* Tex. R. App. P. 52. In the amended petition, relator asks this

Court to compel the presiding judge¹ of the 507th District Court of Harris County, to "reverse its October 28, 2021 ruling denying Relator's Emergency Motion to Stay the Proceedings of the enforcement."

Relator has not established that she is entitled to mandamus relief. Accordingly, we deny relator's amended petition for writ of mandamus.
