## MEMORANDUM OPINION

This is an appeal from an order signed April 21, 2022. The notice of appeal was filed May 5, 2022. To date, our records show that appellant has not paid the appellate filing fee. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 5 (requiring payment of fees in civil cases unless party is excused by statute or by appellate rules from paying costs). Tex. Gov't Code Ann. § 51.207 (appellate fees and costs).

On June 7, 2022, this court ordered appellant to pay the appellate filing fee on or before June 17, 2022 or the appeal would be subject to dismissal without further notice. Appellant has not paid the appellate filing fee or otherwise responded to the court's order. Accordingly, we dismiss the appeal. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 42.3(c) (allowing involuntary dismissal of case because appellant has failed to comply with notice from clerk requiring response or other action within specified time).
