MEMORANDUM OPINION

On August 29, 2022, relator S.G.T. filed a petition for writ of mandamus in this Court. *See* Tex. Gov't Code Ann. § 22.221; *see also* Tex. R. App. P. 52. In the petition, relator asks this Court to compel the Honorable Kerri Foley, presiding judge of the County Court at Law No. 2 of Galveston County, to enter an order granting relator's notice of non-suit. In his sole issue, relator contends the trial court abused its discretion by refusing to sign an order granting a non-suit and that he is entitled to relief as there is no adequate appellate remedy at law.

On October 5, 2022, real party in interest C.C. filed with this court file-stamped copies of several orders filed in the trial court since this mandamus proceeding began, one of which was an order that granted relator's notice of non-suit. As the trial court has granted relator the relief that he ultimately sought in this mandamus proceeding, we deny relator's petition for writ of mandamus as moot.
