MEMORANDUM OPINION

On June 15, 2023, relator Oscar O. Fuentes-Diaz filed a petition for writ of mandamus in this court. *See* Tex. Gov't Code Ann. § 22.221; *see also* Tex. R. App. P. 52. In the petition, relator asks this court to compel the Honorable Mike Engelhart, presiding judge of the 151st District Court of Harris County, to vacate the trial court's May 30, 2023 order denying relator's motion to quash and motion for protection.

On July 12, 2023, relator filed an unopposed motion to dismiss his petition for writ of mandamus, advising that relator's petition is most because on June 23, 2023, the trial court vacated its May 30th order.

Accordingly, we grant relator's unopposed motion and dismiss the petition for writ of mandamus for want of jurisdiction.
