MEMORANDUM OPINION

On September 19, 2023, relators Swan Nject, LLC and Nject Disposal, LLC filed a petition for writ of mandamus in this Court. *See* Tex. Gov't Code Ann. § 22.221; *see also* Tex. R. App. P. 52.
