MEMORANDUM OPINION

This is an appeal from the trial court's order signed September 21, 2023 dismissing appellant's claims against the State of Texas for want of prosecution.¹ Appellant's brief was due December 7, 2023. No brief or motion to extend time was filed.

¹ Appellant has also filed an appeal in case number 14-22-00881-CV, disputing the trial court's order signed September 20, 2022 which dismissed his claims against District Attorney Brian Middleton and declared appellant to be a vexatious litigant. That appeal remains pending.

On January 11, 2024, we issued an order stating that unless appellant filed a brief on or before February 12, 2024, the appeal was subject to dismissal without further notice for want of prosecution. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 42.3(b).

Appellant filed no brief or other response. We dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution.
