PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS DENIED

On September 19, 2011, relator filed a petition for writ of habeas corpus, complaining Sheriff Amadeo Ortiz has failed to give him “good time” credit during his 180 day confinement after being held in contempt for failure to pay child support. However, a relator is not entitled to habeas corpus relief unless he was deprived of his liberty without due process of law, or if we conclude the judgment ordering him confined is void. *See In re Alexander*, 243 S.W.3d 822, 824 (Tex. App.—San Antonio 2007, orig. proceeding). Relator has failed to meet his burden to show

he is entitled to habeas corpus relief. Accordingly, relator's petition for writ of habeas corpus is DENIED.
