On April 30, 2012, the trial court signed an order finding that both Nan Ginger and Caroline Longstreth lacked standing to be appointed guardian and dismissing each of their applications. Both Ginger and Longstreth appealed the order. On November 26, 2012, Longstreth filed a motion to dismiss the appeal because the Ward has died. Ginger has not filed an opposition or any other response to the motion.
