JOINT MOTION TO DISMISS GRANTED; APPEAL DISMISSED

On March 12, 2015, we determined this appeal was appropriate for referral to alternative dispute resolution. Accordingly, we ordered the appeal referred to a mediation settlement conference and suspended all appellate deadlines until April 27, 2015. On April 27, 2015, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss the appeal, stating they have entered into a settlement agreement that resolves all of their disputes that would have been addressed on appeal. Accordingly, the appellate deadlines are reinstated and we grant the joint motion to dismiss and
