Relator filed a petition for writ of mandamus on July 13, 2015. This court granted a temporary stay of the challenged order and requested a response to the petition on July 16, 2015.

The parties have advised that the real parties in interest have nonsuited the underlying action for grandparent access and the case in the trial court has been dismissed. The parties filed a joint motion to dismiss this mandamus proceeding on August 25, 2015. Accordingly, the temporary stay previously ordered by this court is lifted, the joint motion to dismiss is granted, and this original mandamus proceeding is dismissed as moot.
