PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS DENIED

On April 12, 2018, relators filed a petition for writ of mandamus. On August 20, 2018, relators filed an “Emergency Motion for Limited Stay of Underlying Trial Court Proceedings.” The real parties in interest filed a response, to which relators later replied. After considering the petition, response, and reply, this court concludes relators are not entitled to the relief sought. Accordingly, the petition for writ of mandamus is DENIED. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 52.8(a). Relators’ “Emergency Motion for Limited Stay of Underlying Trial Court Proceedings” is DENIED AS MOOT.
