#### PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS DENIED

On August 22, 2018, relator filed a petition for writ of mandamus and a motion for immediate temporary relief. The real parties in interest filed a response. After considering the petition and response and based on the record from the non-evidentiary TRO hearing, we cannot conclude the trial court could have reached only one decision. *Liberty Nat'l Fire Ins. Co. v. Akin*, 927 S.W.2d 627, 630 (Tex. 1996) (orig. proceeding) (quoting *Walker v. Packer*, 827 S.W.2d 833, 840 (Tex. 1992) (orig. proceeding)). Therefore, relator is not entitled to the relief sought. Accordingly, the petition for writ of mandamus is DENIED. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 52.8(a). Relator's motion for immediate temporary relief is MOOT.
