In this appeal of an eviction judgment, Appellant's brief was due on October 26, 2018. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 38.6(a). On November 6, 2018, after no brief or motion for extension of time to file the brief was filed, we ordered Appellant to show cause in writing not later than November 16, 2018, why this appeal should not be dismissed for want of prosecution. *See id.* R. 38.8(a). We warned Appellant that if she failed to show cause in writing as ordered, we could dismiss this appeal without further notice.
