On January 15, 2019, appellant filed a notice of appeal, stating he desires to appeal the overruling, by operation of law, of his motion to dismiss and for speedy trial. On February 20, 2019, this court issued a show cause order notifying appellant that we do not have jurisdiction over appeals of such rulings and must dismiss appeals of those rulings for want of jurisdiction. *See Ordunez v.
