DISMISSED FOR LACK OF JURISDICTION

Appellant appeals from the trial court’s “Order Amending Community Supervision.” This court does not have jurisdiction to consider an appeal from an order altering or modifying community supervision conditions. *Davis v. State*, 195 S.W.3d 708, 710 (Tex. Crim. App. 2006); *Basaldua v. State*, 558 S.W.2d 2, 5 (Tex. Crim. App. 1977); *Quaglia v. State*, 906 S.W.2d 112, 113 (Tex. App.—San Antonio 1995, no pet.).

On April 9, 2019, appellant was ordered to show cause by April 24, 2019, why this appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. Appellant did not respond to this court’s order.

Because appellant is seeking to appeal from an order altering or modifying community supervision conditions for which this court does not have jurisdiction, this appeal is dismissed for lack of jurisdiction.
