On May 6, 2019, relator filed a petition for writ of mandamus in this court asserting Judge Palomo has not taken the action required of a respondent judge pursuant to Texas Rule of Civil Procedure 18a(f). The trial court has provided this court with a courtesy copy of an “Order of Recusal” signed by Judge Palomo on April 28, 2019 in which the judge recused herself. Because relator obtained the relief requested, we dismiss his petition for writ of mandamus as moot.
