DISMISSED FOR WANT OF PROSECUTION

On February 22, 2021, the trial court clerk notified this court that the clerk's record was not filed when it was originally due because appellants had failed to pay or make arrangements to pay the clerk's fee for preparing the record and appellants were not entitled to appeal without paying the fee. On February 24, 2021, this court ordered appellants to show cause in writing by March 5, 2021, why this appeal should not be dismissed for want of prosecution. Appellants did

not respond. Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed for want of prosecution. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 37.3(b), 42.3(b). Costs of the appeal are taxed against appellants.
