PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS DENIED

Relators have filed a petition for writ of mandamus. We may issue writs of mandamus when “agreeable to the principles of law regulating those writs.” TEX. GOV’T CODE § 22.221(b). A relator has the burden to file a petition and record showing “the trial court abused its discretion and that no adequate appellate remedy exists.” *In re H.E.B. Grocery Co., L.P.*, 492 S.W.3d 300, 302 (Tex. 2016) (orig. proceeding) (per curiam). Having reviewed the petition and record, we conclude relators have not satisfied their burden. Accordingly, we deny the petition. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 52.8(a).
