MEMORANDUM OPINION

Proceeding *pro se*, Relator, Alex Melvin Wade Jr., filed a mandamus petition to compel the trial court to rule on his motion for appointment of counsel in a civil suit and to stay all proceedings pending final resolution of Wade's motions. On November 14, 2018, we notified Wade that because it appears he is a vexatious litigant subject to pre-filing orders, the mandamus proceeding would be dismissed unless within ten days he obtained an order from the local administrative judge permitting the filing of the original proceeding. *See* Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code

Ann. §§ 11.101–.104 (West 2017). To date, we have not received a copy of an order signed by the local administrative judge. *See id.* § 11.102. Accordingly, we dismiss the original proceeding for a mandamus petition. *See id.* § 11.1035(b).

PETITION DISMISSED.
