MEMORANDUM OPINION

On August 16, 2022, Hazel Wheaten Dabney filed a notice of appeal complaining of an order on a motion to withdraw as counsel.¹ We notified the parties that it appears the order being appealed is neither a final judgment nor an appealable order. We requested a response be filed by September 19, 2022, and warned that the appeal would be dismissed without further notice unless we received a written reply

that established our jurisdiction over the appeal. The appellant has failed to comply with the notice from the clerk requiring action within a specified time. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 42.3(c). Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed. *Id.* 43.2(f).
