#### MEMORANDUM OPINION

On November 4, 2022, Good Deal Trucking, Inc. and Theodore Putman filed a notice of appeal from an order on a motion for sanctions. We questioned whether the trial court had signed a final judgment for an order that is appealable as an accelerated appeal. Neither party responded to this Court's warning that we would
