MEMORANDUM OPINION¹ AND JUDGMENT

On October 13, 2008, we denied appellant Michelle Kevetter's second "Motion For Extension Of Time For Filing Brief." We notified appellant on November 4, 2008, that her brief had not been filed as required by Texas Rule of Appellate Procedure 38.6(a). Tex. R. App. P. 38.6(a). We further notified appellant that, in accordance with Tex. R. App. P. 42.3(b), this case may be dismissed for want of prosecution unless appellant or any party desiring to continue this appeal filed with the court on or before November 14, 2008, a
