## MEMORANDUM OPINION<sup>1</sup> AND JUDGMENT

Appellant attempts to appeal the entry of a Final Protective Order by the trial court. Appellant's brief was due February 10, 2017. On March 7, 2017, we notified appellant that his brief had not been filed as required by Texas Rule of Appellate Procedure 38.6(a). See Tex. R. App. P. 38.6(a).
