MEMORANDUM OPINION¹

Appellant Juan A Deleon attempts to appeal from a judgment convicting him of aggravated assault with a deadly weapon. The trial court's certification states that this "is a plea-bargain case, and the defendant has NO right of appeal." See Tex. R. App. P. 25.2(a)(2). On December 12, 2016, we notified Deleon that this appeal may be dismissed pursuant to the trial court's certification
