MEMORANDUM OPINION AND JUDGMENT

Appellant's brief was initially due on November 30, 2020. After the parties informed us about their mediation attempts, among other things, appellant's briefing deadline was reset to March 5, 2021.

On March 8, 2021, we notified appellant that her brief had not been filed as the appellate rules require. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 38.6(a). We stated that we could dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution unless, within ten days, she filed with the court an appellant's brief and an accompanying motion reasonably explaining the brief's untimely filing and why an extension was needed. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 10.5(b), 38.8(a)(1), 42.3(b). We have received no response.

Because appellant has failed to file a brief even after we afforded an opportunity to explain the initial failure, we dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 38.8(a)(1), 42.3(b), 43.2(f).

Appellant must pay all costs of this appeal.
