## MEMORANDUM OPINION AND JUDGMENT

On April 13, 2022, we notified appellant that his brief had not been filed as the appellate rules require. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 38.6(a). We stated that we could dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution unless, on or before April 25, 2022, appellant filed with the court an appellant's brief and an accompanying motion reasonably explaining the brief's untimely filing and why an extension was needed. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 10.5(b), 38.8(a)(1), 42.3(b). We have received no response.

Because appellant has failed to file a brief even after we afforded an opportunity to explain the initial failure, we dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 38.8(a)(1), 42.3(b), 43.2(f).
