## MEMORANDUM OPINION AND JUDGMENT

Appellant timely filed a notice of appeal from the June 9, 2022 judgment. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 26.1(b). The newly assigned trial judge then granted appellant's timely filed motion for new trial on August 19, 2022, within the trial court's plenary jurisdiction. *See* Tex. R. Civ. P. 329b(a), (e).

Because the trial court's order moots the appeal, we dismiss the appeal for want of jurisdiction.<sup>1</sup> See Tex. R. App. P. 42.3(a), 43.2(f); *Wilkins v. Methodist Health Care Sys.*, 160 S.W.3d 559, 563 (Tex. 2005). The parties will pay their own costs. See Tex. R. App. P. 43.4.
