Appellant Gregory Ray Roy filed notices of appeal in the referenced matters in which his probation was revoked in Cause No. 07-02-0065-CR and his guilt was adjudicated in Cause Nos. 07-02-0063-CR and 07-02-0064-CR. Because the clerk's record had not been filed due to appellant's failure to pay or make arrangements to pay

for the record, we abated the appeals to the trial court for a hearing. However, appellant has now filed a motion to dismiss his appeals. That motion has been signed by both appellant and his attorney.
