MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant Larry Johnson, proceeding *pro se*, filed a notice of appeal, received by this court on November 13, 2003. Appellant did not pay the filing fees of \$125 or submit an affidavit of indigence pursuant to Rule 20 of the Rules of Appellate Procedure.

On December 1, 2003, this Court received a Motion for Leave to Proceed in Forma Pauperis and an Affidavit of Poverty from appellant. The motion was denied.

By letter dated January 22, 2004, the clerk of this court notified appellant that the filing fee had not been paid, and that failure to pay it could result in dismissal. Tex. R. App. P. 42.3(c).

The filing fee has not been paid. Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed. TEX. R. APP. P. 42.3.
