MEMORANDUM OPINION

Before QUINN, C.J. and HANCOCK and PIRTLE, JJ.

Pending before this Court is a motion to dismiss filed by Appellant, Susan McDonald. By this motion Appellant represents she and Appellee, Samuel A. Hendricks, have compromised and settled their differences which are the basis of this appeal. Without passing on the merits of the appeal, McDonald's motion is granted and the appeal is dismissed.
