## **MEMORANDUM OPINION**

Before QUINN, C.J., and PIRTLE and DOSS, JJ.

By separate notices of appeal, Appellant, Stephen Patrick Black, proceeding prose, sought to appeal the judgment entered in trial court cause number DCV-19872-18 and the order granting a petition for bill of review entered in trial court cause number DCV-20282-19. Now pending before this court are Appellant's motions seeking voluntary

dismissal of those appeals.
