ORDER OF ABATEMENT AND REMAND

Before QUINN, C.J., and PARKER and DOSS, JJ.

Appellant, Fernando Adame, Jr., appeals his convictions for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon¹ and for failure to stop and render aid following a traffic accident.² He was sentenced to sixty years' confinement for aggravated assault and ten years' confinement for failure to stop and render aid, with the sentences to run concurrently.

The reporter's record was due January 31, 2022, but was not filed. The Court has been notified that the reporter, Krista Hodges, passed away on January 16, 2022.
