## MEMORANDUM OPINION

Before QUINN, C.J., and PARKER and DOSS, JJ.

Appellant Bianca M. Woods, proceeding pro se, appeals from the trial court's Final

Summary Judgment.<sup>1</sup> Woods's brief was originally due March 21, 2022, but was not filed.

We subsequently granted Woods three extensions to file a brief. By letter of May 23,

2022, we notified Woods that the appeal was subject to dismissal for want of prosecution,

without further notice, if a brief was not received by June 20. To date, Woods has not filed a brief nor had any further communication with this Court.
