MEMORANDUM OPINION

Before QUINN, C.J., and PARKER and YARBROUGH, JJ.

Appellant, Henry T. Alvarado, appeals from the trial court's *Final Decree of Divorce*. Appellant's brief was due September 19, 2022, but was not filed. By letter of September 28, 2022, we notified Appellant that the appeal was subject to dismissal for want of prosecution, without further notice, if a brief was not received by October 10. To date, Appellant has neither filed a brief nor had any further communication with this Court.
