#### **MEMORANDUM OPINION**

Before QUINN, C.J., and DOSS and YARBROUGH, JJ.

Appellant, Recaro Aircraft Seating Americas, LLC, appeals from the trial court's judgment.<sup>1</sup> Now pending before this Court is Appellant's unopposed motion seeking voluntary dismissal of the appeal. The Court finds that the motion complies with the requirements of Rule of Appellate Procedure 42.1(a)(1) and that granting the motion will

not prevent any party from seeking relief to which it would otherwise be entitled. As no decision of the Court has been delivered to date, we grant the motion. The appeal is dismissed. Pursuant to the motion, costs shall be taxed against the parties who incurred them. See Tex. R. App. P. 42.1(d). No motion for rehearing will be entertained and our mandate will issue forthwith.
