**MEMORANDUM OPINION**

**Before QUINN, C.J., and DOSS and YARBROUGH, JJ.**

Appellant, Alisa Subhamitr Lesslie, appeals her conviction for driving while intoxicated<sup>1</sup> and sentence to ninety days' confinement, suspended in favor of community supervision for fifteen months.<sup>2</sup> Pending before this Court is Appellant's motion to voluntarily dismiss the appeal.
