Calvin Yarbrough has filed a document with this Court that we deem to be a request for

relief through a petition for writ of mandamus. He has no pending appeal, but asks us to order

the Harrison County District Clerk to produce and provide him with a complete certified

transcription of the grand jury minutes, presumably from the cause underlying his 2005 conviction

for aggravated assault.

This Court has jurisdiction to issue a writ of mandamus against "a judge of a district or

county court in the court of appeals district." TEX. GOV'T CODE ANN. § 22.221(b) (Vernon 2004).

In this context, the relief sought by Yarbrough against a district clerk is not within the

jurisdictional authority of this Court.

We deny the petition for writ of mandamus.
