MEMORANDUM OPINION

Daniel Lee Ainsworth attempts to appeal from an order denying his application for writ of habeas corpus. The Clerk of this Court notified Ainsworth by letter dated June 15, 2011 that his appeal was subject to dismissal for want of jurisdiction. The Clerk also warned Ainsworth that the Court would dismiss the appeal unless, within 21 days of the date of the letter, a response was filed showing grounds for continuing the appeal.
