**MEMORANDUM OPINION**

Appellant, John Margetis, appeals from a “writ of possession” entered in favor of appellee, High Pointe Investments, LLC. By letter dated August 7, 2018, the Clerk of this Court notified appellant that the appeal was subject to dismissal because appellant’s notice of appeal is untimely, and because the complained-of order—the writ of possession—is not an appealable order. Accordingly, the Clerk warned appellant that the Court would dismiss the appeal unless, within ten days from the date of the letter,

appellant filed a response showing grounds for continuing this appeal. Ten days have passed, and appellant has not responded to our August 7, 2018 letter. Accordingly, we hereby dismiss this appeal. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.3(c).
