**MEMORANDUM OPINION**

Appellant, Matthew Mark Heslep, appeals from an "Order to Withdraw Funds" signed by the trial court on August 24, 2018. By letter dated February 22, 2019, the Clerk of this Court notified appellant that the appeal is subject to dismissal because the original filing fee had not been paid and warned appellant that the Court would dismiss the appeal unless, within ten days from the date of the letter, appellant paid the filing fee or obtained indigent status for the purpose of appeal.
