Health & Safety Code Ann. § 481.121 (West 2010). The district court has certified that Edmonds has waived her right of appeal. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 25.2(a)(2); *Monreal v. State*, 99 S.W.2d 615, 622 (Tex. Crim. App. 2003). Accordingly, we dismiss the appeal on that ground. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 25.2(a)(2), (d).
