MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant filed a notice of appeal in this Court, complaining of a judgment signed by the justice court. However, this Court lacks jurisdiction over justice-court judgments. That jurisdiction lies in the county or district court. *See* Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code § 51.001; *see also id.* § 51.012 (person may appeal from district or county court to court of appeals). We therefore dismiss the appeal for want of jurisdiction.¹ Tex. R. App. P. 42.3(a).
