MEMORANDUM OPINION

The appellate record was due to be filed February 21, 2014. In early March, we were notified that appellant had not made arrangements for the record to be filed, and on March 19, we sent appellant a letter asking him to make arrangements for the record and send us a status report no later than March 31.
