MEMORANDUM OPINION

Tracy Larance Gordon was convicted of possession of a controlled substance. *See* Tex. Health & Safety Code § 481.115. The district court has certified that the case is a plea-bargain case and that appellant has no right to appeal. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 25.2(a)(2). Accordingly, we dismiss the appeal. *See id.* R. 25.2(d) (mandating that if trial court does not certify that defendant has right to appeal, “appeal must be dismissed”).
