ORDER AND MEMORANDUM OPINION

PER CURIAM

Appellant Ramon Saldana appeals the district court's judgment of conviction. However, there is conflicting information in the clerk's record about Saldana's right to appeal, reflecting both Saldana's waiver of his right to appeal and the trial court's certification that Saldana has the right to appeal. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 25.2(a)(2), (d) (requiring trial court's certification of defendant's right of appeal); *see also Alexander v. State*, No. 03-16-00503-CR, 2016 Tex. App. LEXIS 9685, at *1 (Tex. App.—Austin Aug. 31, 2016, no pet.) (mem. op., not designated for publication) (abating appeal based on similar conflict in clerk's record).

Accordingly, we abate this appeal and remand the cause to the trial court for entry of an amended certification clarifying Saldana's right of appeal. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 25.2(f). A supplemental clerk's record containing the trial court's amended certification shall be filed with this Court on or before July 27, 2017. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 25.2(d), 34.5(c)(2), 37.1.
