MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant Stephanie Michelle Hurdsman seeks to appeal from an order denying her pretrial application for writ of habeas corpus. *See* Tex. Code Crim. Proc. arts. 11.05, 11.08. The trial court signed the order denying relief on April 26, 2016. Therefore, the deadline for perfecting appeal was May 26, 2016. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 26.2(a)(1). Appellant filed her notice of appeal on May 24, 2017. Thus, appellant’s notice of appeal—filed 393 days after the order was entered—is untimely.

Absent a timely filed notice of appeal, we do not obtain jurisdiction to address the merits of the appeal in a criminal case and can take no action other than to dismiss the appeal for want of jurisdiction. *See Slaton v. State*, 981 S.W.2d 208, 210 (Tex. Crim. App. 1998); *Olivo v. State*, 918 S.W.2d 519, 522–23 (Tex. Crim. App. 1996). Accordingly, we dismiss this appeal for want of jurisdiction.
