## MEMORANDUM OPINION

Before Justices Garza, Perkes, and Longoria  
Memorandum Opinion Per Curiam

The appellant's brief in the above cause was originally due on May 20, 2016. Appellant has previously requested and received one extension of time to file the brief on or before July 18, 2016. On August 15, 2016, the Clerk of the Court notified appellant

that the brief had not been timely filed and that the appeal was subject to dismissal for want of prosecution under Texas Rule of Appellate Procedure 38.8(a)(1), unless within ten days from the date of receipt of the Clerk's letter, appellant reasonably explained the failure and the appellee was not significantly injured by the appellant's failure to timely file a brief. To date, no response has been received from appellant.

Appellant has failed to either reasonably explain his failure to file a brief, file a motion for extension of time to file his brief, or file his brief. Accordingly, the appeal is DISMISSED FOR WANT OF PROSECUTION. See TEX. R. APP. P. 38.8(a), 42.3(b).
