MEMORANDUM OPINION

Memorandum Opinion Per Curiam**

Appellant, Dianayancy Martinez, filed an appeal from a judgment entered by the County Court at Law No. 6 of Hidalgo County, Texas, in cause number F-5491-15-6. This cause is before the Court on appellant's motion to dismiss the appeal on grounds the trial court set aside and vacated the judgment based upon the agreement of the
