### **MEMORANDUM OPINION**

# Before Chief Justice Valdez and Justices Rodriguez and Benavides Memorandum Opinion Per Curiam

This appeal was abated by this Court on August 12, 2016, to allow the parties an opportunity to finalize a settlement agreement. This cause is now before the Court on appellant's unopposed motion to dismiss the appeal on grounds the parties have reached a settlement agreement resolving all their disputes relating to this interlocutory appeal.

Appellant requests that this Court dismiss the appeal and tax the costs of appeal against appellant. Accordingly, this case is hereby REINSTATED.
