MEMORANDUM OPINION

Before Justices Contreras, Benavides, and Longoria Memorandum Opinion by Justice Contreras

Appellant, Oscar Enrique Mendez, M.D., perfected an appeal from a judgment

entered by the 275th District Court of Hidalgo County, Texas, in cause number C-8356-

14-E. Appellant has filed an amended unopposed motion to dismiss the appeal on

grounds that he no longer desires to pursue the appeal. Appellant requests that this Court dismiss the appeal.
